**Notification of Skill Development Promotion Committee**

**Titled “Qualification of Applicant for Skill Standard Testing of  
Older Person Caregiving”**

According to section 22 of Skill Development Promotion Act (B.E.2545) 2002, Skill Development Promotion Committee sets up the qualification of applicant for skill standard testing on Older Person Caregiving as follows:

1. National skill standard on Older Person Caregiving level 2
  - 1.1 Applicant must not be lower than 18 years old.
  - 1.2 Applicant must not have lower than secondary school graduation.
  - 1.3 Applicant must have medical certificate for good physical and mental health.
  - 1.4 Applicant must complete training course on Older Person Caregiving not less than 300 hours (not less than 200 hours for theory and not less than 100 hours for practical training) **OR**
  - 1.5 Applicant must complete training course on Older Person Caregiving not less than 100 hours from government agencies or certified training center and has experiences on older person caregiving in government or private agencies not less than 2 years.
